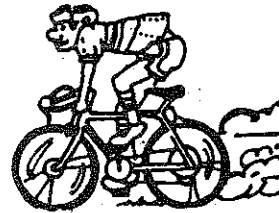

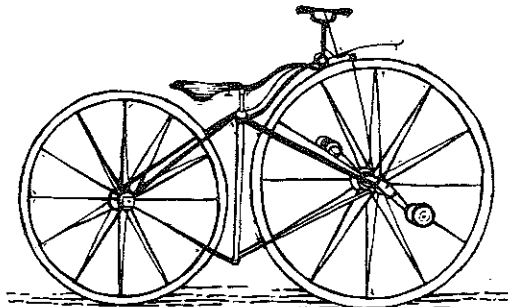

Riding Grade System

July 7- Ken Koch's annual Bloomer Boomer. There will be 3 starting points depending on the number of miles wished to be ridden.  
For 106 miles leave from Pavlats at 6:00 a.m. for an A pace ride to 29 mile and VanDyke.  
For 76 miles, meet at the Big Boy Restaurant on 29 mile and VanDyke at 7:00 a.m.

For a 56 mile ride meet at 32 mile and Rochester Rd. at 8:00 a.m.  
for a B pace ride to Bloomer State Park.  
Breakfast will then be in Lake Orion at Marge's Restaurant.

July 13- One Helluva Ride

This ride starts from Wylie School in Dexter. Club members will be meeting there at 7:00 a.m. to ride together. Registration forms can be obtained at Pavlats.

July 14- River Raisin Tour

This ride starts from Monroe County Community College. The routes are 31, 62 and 100 miles. Registration is \$7.00 and members are planning to meet at 7:30 a.m. to ride together at the college.

July 21- BWR pre-rides

John Edry will be leading an A pace ride of the 100 mile and 200K routes, beginning at 7:00 a.m. from St. Clair H.S. A brunch stop will be in Marine City.

Rick Moorman will lead the 100K route from St. Clair H.S. at 8:00. This will be a B+ pace ride. Rick will also be leaving from Pavlats at 6:00 a.m. for an A pace ride, to St. Clair H.S., for a total of 108 miles.

Ron Skiba will be leading the 50K route from St. Clair H.S. at 8:30 a.m. at a C+ pace.

Be sure to bring money for ferry crossings and ID.

July 26- Friday Fish Fry Dinner Ride
